## Editor Enhancements – Block Commenting

Version 10.1 allows a number of lines to be commented and de-commented with one keystroke, and from the Editor menu.

Once a section of code has been selected (with the mouse or keyboard), pressing Ctrl+Alt+Comma adds a comment symbol to the start of each line.

Pressing Ctrl+Alt+Dot removes a single comment symbol (if present) from the beginning of each line.

The keystrokes used for adding and removing comments are, like all other commands, defined in the Input Table and you may re-map the keys by editing your .DIN file. The relevant codes are as follows:

Input Code	Keystroke	Description
AO	Ctrl+Alt+Comma	Add Comment
DO	Ctrl+Alt+Dot	Delete Comment

Notes:

- An additional comment is added whether or not there is already one there.
- The comment on the first line of selection is positioned where the selection begins

### □PATH

Double-clicking in the editor now checks the current value of □PATH prior to opening a non-existent symbol for editing.

## GoTo Line

The editor now supports a Go to Line feature. Selecting Go to Line from the Editor's Edit menu prompts for a target line number. There is currently no key binding to go directly to this dialog box.

## Localisation Menuitem

The editor menu now includes a menu shortcut to toggle the localisation of the name under the cursor.
