

- requirements: build in & around Hologram
 - ASP.NET 1.1
 - Dyalog APL 10.1
 - SQL Server (2000)
- what we ended up with:
 - ASP.NET 1.1 + 2.0 !
 - Dyalog APL 10.1
 - SQL Server (2000) (and 2005-compatibility-headache)
 - C#, VB.net, JavaScript
 - •...and the challenge to move to Oracle! \odot

COPA-MS: under the hood





• ASP.NET 1.1 & 2.0: master-data management

- Using Dyalog 10.1 to create ASPx-files (48x ASP 1.1, 34x ASP 2.0) from definitions held in database (field & screen-definitions)
- ASP 1.1: establish connection with Hologram, record-selection for master-data mgmt. (write result of selection to db)
- ASP 2.0: results of selections, view/edit selected records (get sel from db)


• All other functionality in ASP.NET 1.1 and Dyalog 10.1 (more ,internal', dataprocessing stuff, using Hologram for presentation of results)






- ASP.NET (sometimes) sucks
 - ViewState leads to HUGE files
 - ,strange' effects during stress-tests
- ASP.NET is continously expanding / evolving / whatever:
 - ASP.NET 1.1 (2003): no gridview
 - ASP.NET 2.0 (2005): GridView (Read-Only, Edit)
 - ASP.NET 3.5 (Nov 2007): ListView with features to build a GridView with Insert!
 - oh yes, and there never was a ASP.NET 3.0 (Thanks, Bill!)
- Sharing session-variables (or session-state) between ASP.NET 1.1 and ASP.NET 2.0 is not possible on IIS6 (but should work on IIS7, I heard)



COPA-MS: Summary / Recommendation





It's not about APL or C#

The ,real' question is how deep you want to get into ASP.NET (*i.e. if you use its controls & events*) or if you (*want to / can afford to*) stay away from it

I don't have a real recommendation for all cases and everyone, it is an individual decision.


