

Arriving in Denmark

The nearest and most convenient airport for the venue is:

• CPH: Copenhagen Airport Kastrup (60 km/35 miles)

Copenhagen Airport Kastrup is the busiest airport in Scandinavia and is connected by direct flights with many cities, including London, New York, Berlin, Rome and Amsterdam. There are two terminals; terminal 2 and terminal 3.

Getting to Konventum from Copenhagen Airport Kastrup

There are various options for getting to the hotel.

...by train

There is no longer a direct train (Danish: Tog) from Copenhagen Airport Kastrup to Elsinore (Danish: Helsingør). Instead, you need to get either the train or metro and then change to the train to Helsingør.

- Buying your ticket: Tickets cover going by train or going by metro and train, and cost approximately DKK100 each way. You can purchase a ticket:
 - at the DSB ticket office in Terminal 3; this is on the right-hand side after exiting the baggage claims/customs area. The ticket office accepts cash or credit cards, ticket machines only accept coins.
 - o online.

You cannot buy tickets on the train/metro, and you can be fined if you board without a valid ticket.

- OPTION 1 Train to Copenhagen central station (Københavns Hovedbanegård): The station
 is next to the ticket office. The trains have two directions so make sure you do not get on a
 train to Sweden! At Københavns Hovedbanegård, trains for Helsingør usually depart from
 platforms 1-4, but it could be different check the screens in the main hall.
- OPTION 2 Metro to Nørreport St: This is the slightly quicker option. The Metro station is at
 the end of Terminal 3, up the stairs. Follow the big signs with an "M" on them. All the metros
 from the airport stop at Nørreport St, so you do not have to worry about getting on the right
 one. At Nørreport, trains for Helsingør leave from track 1 follow the signs with a little train
 on them to find it. Do not get an "S" train, as it will not take you to Helsingør.

Helsingør station is the last station on the line. From here, there are two ways to get to Konventum:

- By bus: the bus stop is directly outside the station. The train ticket from Copenhagen airport
 is also valid on buses in Helsingør. You will want the number 353 bus heading to Hellebo
 Park (the last stop, but do tell the driver where you are going as the bus turns round
 after this stop and returns to Helsingør). The bus runs every 30 minutes and the
 journey takes about 10 minutes.
 - Timetable for bus 353 (Helsingør St. Hellebo Park)
- By taxi: The taxi rank is directly outside the station. A taxi from Elsinore station to
 Konventum will cost approximately DKK200 (rates include the tip), depending on the time of
 the day and the size of the car, and all taxis accept credit cards. The taxi driver might know
 Konventum by its former name of LO-skolen.

...by taxi

You can find a taxi at the taxi rank (directly outside Terminal 3); taxis do not need to be booked in advance. A taxi from Copenhagen Airport Kastrup to Konventum will cost approximately DKK1500 (rates include the tip), depending on the time of the day and the size of the car, and all taxis accept credit cards. Note that Uber is illegal in Denmark.
